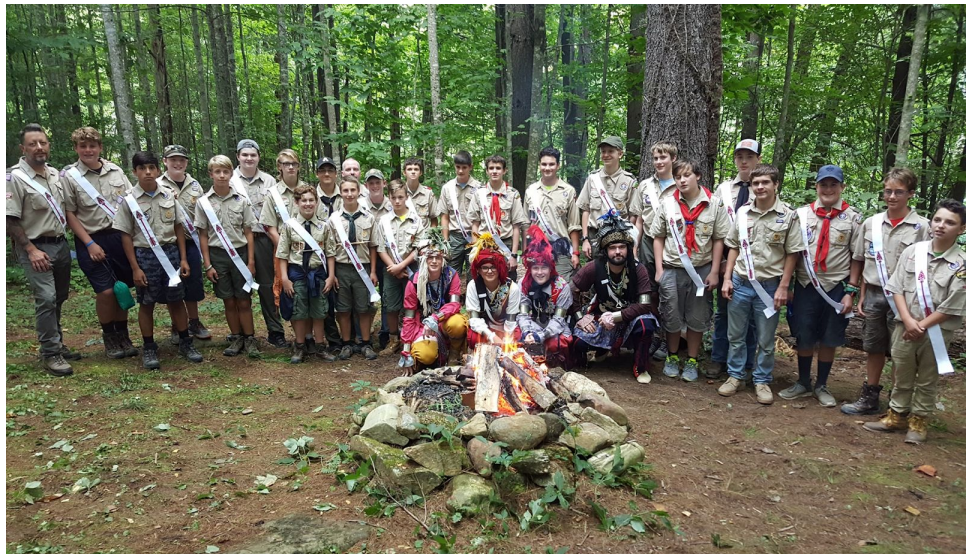

# Lodge Officer Elections

Brothers!

Our annual Lodge Officer Elections will occur at Fall Fellowship, which is only three weeks away on October 5-7! Elected positions are open to any lodge member, in good standing, under the age of 21 for the entire term of their office. These positions are Treasurer, Secretary, Vice-Chief of Program, Vice-Chief of Indian Affairs, Vice-Chief of Administration, and Lodge Chief. Each officer is the chair of certain committees and is responsible for certain projects throughout the year. The specifics of each position are as follows:

- 1. Lodge Chief:** Presides at all Lodge Executive Board Meetings, supervises all Lodge Vice- Chiefs and committee chairmen and sees that they carry out their duties, sees that all Lodge functions are properly planned for and conducted, consults regularly with the Lodge Lay and Staff Advisers; voting member of Daniel Boone Council Executive Board; attends section Council of Chiefs meetings.
- 2. Lodge Vice-Chief of Administration:** Responsible for the planbook, NEXT Guide, on-site operations at fellowships, and Brotherhood Conversion.
- 3. Lodge Vice-Chief of Indian Affairs:** Generally responsible for and oversees every Indian Affairs aspect of our lodge. He is responsible for making sure the Ceremony teams and Dance teams are ready for each event.
- 4. Lodge Vice-Chief of Program:** Responsible for planning every lodge event. During Ordeals, he is overseeing the work being completed by the clans, and activities during fellowships.
- 5. Lodge Secretary:** Responsible for taking minutes at all Lodge Executive Meetings, copying those notes and distributing them at the next Executive Meeting; completes official Lodge correspondence. He also publishes the lodge newsletter. Is responsible for communication throughout the lodge
- 6. Lodge Treasurer:** Responsible for monitoring all lodge financial accounts, as well as giving regular finance reports to the LECM. Also responsible for creating an annual budget, in conjunction with the key-3.

Each candidate is offered a three minute speech to address the lodge and explain their plans for the term in their desired position. I encourage you all to think about how well you would fit in these positions and what you could bring to the lodge if you were elected as an officer. Here is a very interesting flap that should cause some serious attention and is very hard to come by. It's the tan border S21 that was given to officers in the Tsali Lodge in 1985. It was also the 75th Anniversary, 1910-1985, of the founding of the Boy Scouts of America. I don't have very much info on this flap, like how many were made or given out. 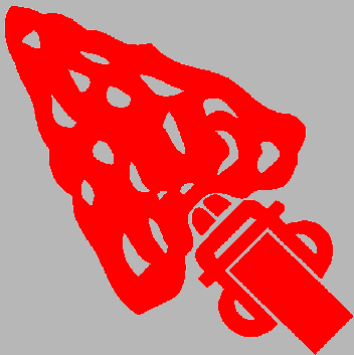
