Tsali Singers Twisted Rawhide Bring Home a National Championship from NOAC!

In December of 2005 Kelly Snead arranged for a friend from Oklahoma, Bo Limbaugh, to come to Asheville and lead a Southern Plains Indian singing seminar. After weekly practices throughout 2006 Tsali entered a group in the team singing competition at NOAC, placing third nationally. In 2009 "Twisted Rawhide", our Southern Drum Team's name, returned to NOAC and captured the National Championship! Since 2009 Tsali has entered a team at each NOAC and has placed third each time... until now! Singing two very difficult Kiowa songs, our 2018 NOAC Sing Team again captured the National Championship!

Eli Kayne led a Kiowa War Mother's song. Kiowa mothers of soldiers formed the American War Mothers, a national organization incorporated by an Act of Congress. Kiowa singers responded by putting Kiowa words into Round Dance songs to commemorate the service of Kiowa veterans. The song Eli led was composed by Frank Kaubin, thinking about his son who was serving in Vietnam.

Kevin Donahue led a Kiowa Gourd Dance Song. A Kiowa story recounts the tale of a young man who had been separated from the rest of



the tribe. Hungry and dehydrated after many days of travel, the young man approached a hill and heard an unusual kind of singing coming from the other side. There he saw a red wolf singing and dancing on its hind legs, holding a rattle and a feather fan. The man listened to the songs all afternoon and through the night and when morning came, the wolf spoke to him and told him to take the dance and songs back to the Kiowa people. At the end of each gourd dance song the singers "howl" as a tribute to the red wolf.

Singing Team Advisor Mark Birdsong was one of the original "Twisted Rawhide" singers in 2006 and coached the team over the last few years as they have learned these very difficult songs.
