Important Dues Price Notice

Hello, Tsali Lodge.

For the past several years, the price for membership in Tsali Lodge 134 has been \$15 annually. However, effective immediately, **this price has been changed to \$20 per year**. This means that from now on, the dues payment form for the 2022 or 2023 year will charge an additional five dollars.

If you have paid dues preemptively for the coming 2023 year, you do not have to pay the difference. However from this point forward anyone paying for lodge membership will have to pay \$20.

Though Tsali Lodge 134 does not strive to make money as its primary goal, funding is a necessary element to having a complete program. This change has been made in order to reflect the current expenses of events at the Lodge, so that they can continue to be offered at a consistent price.


