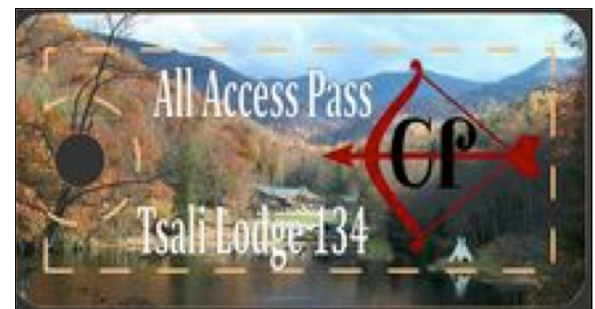

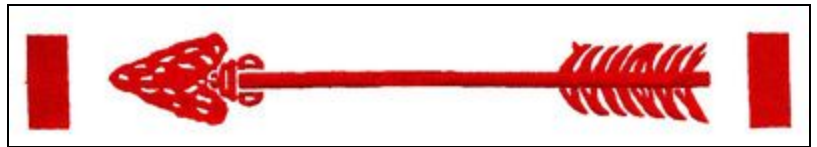

◆ February's Featured Patch

Here is a flap that closely resembles a patch I featured in the Winter Bow. It's the 2006 NOAC S56 flap. In 2006, the NOAC was held at Michigan State University East Lansing, Michigan. Since the Dixie 2006 flap had been designed for Dixie that year, the design was carried to this flap with only a change in the name of events and the silver border in the place of the gold. It was made up as a mock crest with the lodge totem, palm fronds, golf clubs and a ball. The flap was designed by Todd Knaperek and he supplied me with this information.
