Indian Affairs Committee Update

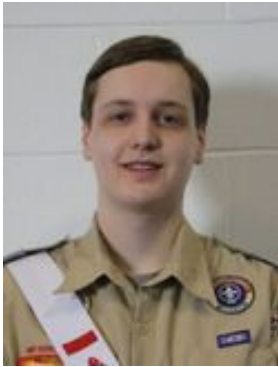
Hell Brothers,

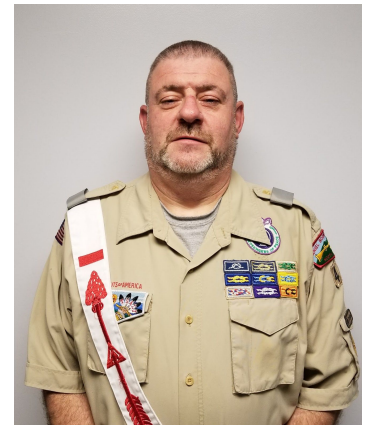


