

Tsali Lodge Supporting Ukraine

In light of the recent conflicts in Ukraine, a large humanitarian crisis in Europe is underway. In order to help, Tsali Lodge designed and sold patches bearing the Ukrainian coat of arms and national colors. Right away, each set sold out, raising a total of \$4,500 for charities including the United Nations Refugee Agency, Sunflower of Peace, CARE, Doctors Without Borders, and UNICEF.

Though the patches are sold out on the website, a few sets will be available in-person for those attending Spring Fellowship for \$30.

If you would like to do more to help please consider donating to any of the above organizations yourselves. Though the danger is across the Atlantic, the safety of all people affected by the war is on the hearts and minds of the Arrowmen of Tsali Lodge.





