1. Do I have to play drums or another musical instrument in order to join the Drum Team? Of course not; all are welcome!

2. How often does the Drum Team practice? Typically every other week during the year, but we may have extra practices right before Conclave. We also practice at each Tsali event at CDB. Tentative upcoming practice schedule dates are Feb 21, Mar 6 & 20, April 3, April 6 (Spring Ordeal), April 10, 17, 24.

3. Where does the Drum Team practice? Usually at Lodge Adviser Kayne's house or at Camp Daniel Boone during event weekends.
