If you're not sure yet what to do with your summer, the OA High Adventure program may be right for you. I've been to two of the BSA's national high adventure bases through OA High Adventure, and it's been highly inspirational both times. With any of the programs, the general idea is that you spend the first half of your time there doing service work like the OA is known for. For the second half, you get to explore everything the base has to offer, and you even get to see things that you'd never see by going there with a troop. It's truly the next step for older arrowmen.

Through these programs, I've navigated with the north star, rafted in Class V rapids, and sheltered through thunderstorms. I still keep in touch with some of the friends I met on my trek two years ago, because these programs cause you to become incredibly close to your crew.

Now, for the best part, these programs are CHEAP!! Some of you may expect a certain price based on your troop's previous experiences, but OA High Adventure costs a lot less. When I went to Summit, I paid them \$275 for eight days. I was at Northern Tier for 15 days, and I only paid them \$200!


