
Message from the Lodge Chief

In 1987 I became an ordeal member of Tsali lodge and was awarded Eagle Scout in 1988. Shortly after getting my Eagle I went off to college and did not get back into scouting until my boys joined Cub Scouts starting in 2004. I have held most of the adult leadership positions in Pack and Troop 40 in Candler. I was also active in Daniel Boone Councils adult training programs including several times on Wood Badge staff. I was a District Training Chair and a Unit Commissioner as well. Both of my sons are Eagle Scouts and one took to the Tsali lodge Indian Affairs program so heavily that I decided if i was gonna be there, I should at least be an adviser. 
