This was the first one issued in honor of the Group Dance Champions at the 2006 Dixie. There wasn't much to the design and Hank Birdsong placed the order. 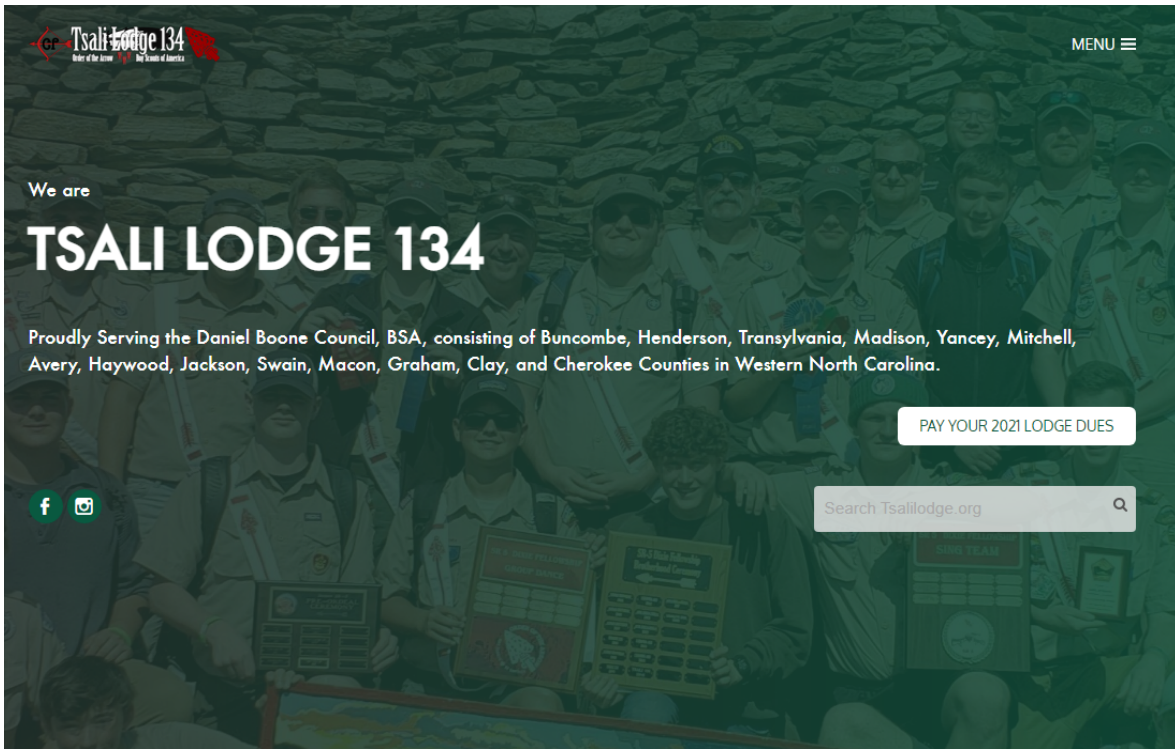
