This was the first one issued in honor of the Group Dance Champions at the 2006 Dixie. There wasn't much to the design and Hank Birdsong placed the order. They didn't think they would need too many so only 100 of the Dance Team strips were ordered. A lot were sewn on jackets so finding one for a collection became an issue. This patch is sought after by many collectors and acquiring one may take a while and a few coins or high end flaps to trade. 


